Recommendations for building emotional connections with children while wearing masks and practicing social distancing with their families will be discussed. Resources for reconnecting with families and considerations for a re-opening plan will be made available.

Stress and Coping: Supporting Children and Families During the Pandemic October 7, 2020 from 7:00-8:00pm

Whether or not early learning and care programs are open during the pandemic, the stressors associated with COVID-19 can impact all young children and their families. More than ever, children need the support of responsive adults to help regulate their emotions and behaviors. This one-hour session highlights ways to be a calming presence for children and build their capacity to self-regulate.

- Calming strategies for young children
- Increasing the use of positive attention
- Strategies for parents when addressing challenging behavior
- Tips for supporting yourself during stressful times

Understanding Bias to Transform Your Equity Journey December 9, 2020 from 4:00-5:00pm

How do we understand bias, both personally and in our work with young children and their families? This one-hour session provides insight into the impact of race, prejudice and stereotyping in our daily lives - and how we can transform ourselves and bring an equity lens to our work in early learning and care programs.
